1.7	Subd. 10. Research director. The commission may select and employ a research director
1.8	who shall perform the duties the commission directs, including the hiring of any clerical
1.9	help and other employees as the commission shall approve. The research director and other
1.10	staff shall be in the unclassified service of the state and their. The compensation of the
1.11	research director and other staff shall be established pursuant to chapter 43A. They shall
1.12	be reimbursed for the expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of their official
1.13	duties in the same manner as other state employees.
