- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to energy; requiring electric utilities to include information on renewable
- 1.3 energy programs with bill inserts; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
- 1.4 Statutes, chapter 216B.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **[216B.1683] RENEWABLE ENERGY PROGRAMS; BILL INSERTS.**
- 1.7 At least twice annually, a utility providing retail electric service to customers in Minnesota
- 1.8 must enclose with each customer's monthly electricity bill information regarding programs
- 1.9 and financial incentives offered by the utility that are designed to encourage use of energy
- 1.10 generated by renewable energy sources. The utility must send a copy of the information to
- 1.11 the commission.
- 1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION.** This section is effective the day following
- 1.13 final enactment. A utility providing retail electric service must begin providing the bill
- 1.14 inserts required under this section no later than September 1, 2020.
