

2.1 (b) The adjutant general shall make grants to local units of government to reimburse
2.2 them for salary and benefits paid to public safety employees on authorized leave under this
2.3 section.

2.4 (c) To be eligible for state reimbursement of the amount of salary and benefits paid for
2.5 the preceding calendar year as determined under this subdivision, the local unit of government
2.6 shall apply to the adjutant general by March 15. By July 15, the adjutant general shall pay
2.7 the reimbursement grants to the local units of government.

2.8 (d) The adjutant general shall prescribe the form and supporting information that must
2.9 be supplied by the local unit of government as part of the application for state reimbursement.

2.10 (e) An appropriation by law from the general fund to the adjutant general must be used
2.11 to pay the grants. If the appropriation is insufficient to pay the entire sum of all of the
2.12 reimbursements for eligible costs for which local units of government have applied, the
2.13 adjutant general shall reduce each grant proportionally so that the sum of the grants equals
2.14 the available appropriation.

2.15 Sec. 3. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2.16 Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following final enactment for reimbursement of
2.17 eligible costs incurred by local units of government in calendar year 2020 and thereafter.
