1.8	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 256I.05, subdivision 1g, is amended to read:
1.9	Subd. 1g. Supplementary service rate for certain facilities. An agency may negotiate
1.10	a supplementary service rate for recipients of assistance under section 256I.04, subdivision
1.11	1, paragraph (a) or (b), who have experienced long-term homelessness and who live in a
1.12	supportive housing establishment under section 256I.04, subdivision 2a, paragraph (b),
1.13	clause (2). An agency may increase the supplementary service rate for recipients under this
1.14	subdivision by \$50 per month.
1.15	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective July 1, 2018.
