1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 157.15, subdivision 8, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 8. Lodging establishment. (a) "Lodging establishment" means a any
1.8	residential or commercial building, structure, enclosure, or any part thereof used as,
1.9	maintained as, or advertised as, or held out to be a place, where sleeping accommodations
1.10	are furnished to the public as regular roomers, for periods of one week or more, and
1.11	having five or more beds to let to the public. A lodging establishment includes, but is
1.12	not limited to:
1.13	(1) a hotel, motel, or bed and breakfast where sleeping accommodations are
1.14	furnished to the public;
1.15	(2) a resort which is located on, or on property neighboring, any lake, stream, skiing
1.16	or hunting area, or any recreational area for purposes of providing convenient access to
1.17	the public and a place where sleeping accommodations are furnished to the public and
1.18	primarily to the public seeking recreation; or
1.19	(3) any other residential or commercial building as described in subdivision 8a.

Repealed Minnesota Statutes: 10-5943

157.15 DEFINITIONS.

Subd. 7. **Hotel or motel.** "Hotel or motel" means a building, structure, enclosure, or any part thereof used as, maintained as, advertised as, or held out to be a place where sleeping accommodations are furnished to the public and furnishing accommodations for periods of less than one week.

Subd. 11. **Resort.** "Resort" means a building, structure, enclosure, or any part thereof located on, or on property neighboring, any lake, stream, skiing or hunting area, or any recreational area for purposes of providing convenient access thereto, kept, used, maintained, or advertised as, or held out to the public to be a place where sleeping accommodations are furnished to the public, and primarily to those seeking recreation for periods of one day, one week, or longer, and having for rent five or more cottages, rooms, or enclosures.
