1.9	public school may not have or adopt a name, symbol, or image that depicts or refers to an
1.10	American Indian Tribe, individual, custom, or tradition to be used as a mascot, nickname,
1.11	logo, letterhead, or team name of the school, district, or school within the district, unless
1.12	the school has obtained an exemption under subdivision 3.
1.13	(b) The prohibition in paragraph (a) does not apply to a public school located within the
1.14	reservation of a federally recognized Tribal Nation in Minnesota, where at least 95 percent
1.15	of students meet the state definition of American Indian student.
1.16	(c) The commissioner must establish a process for a public school to apply for funding
1.17	to make changes necessary to replace a prohibited name, symbol, or image on uniforms,
1.18	signs, paintings, equipment, gym floors, websites, and other school property, including
1.19	supplies and other building surfaces. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
