1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. [15.4741] LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY FEES.
1.6	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no representative of the state shall enter
1.7	into a contract for legal services with a private attorney, in a lawsuit where the state is a
1.8	party, in which the attorney fees paid by the state are more than the greater of \$100,000 or
1.9	two percent of the settlement amount. A contract contemplating more than the greater of
1.10	\$100,000 or two percent of the settlement amount must be submitted to the Legislative
1.11	Advisory Commission for approval.
