1.5	Section 1. MILL TOWNS AND SAKATAH SINGING HILLS STATE TRAILS -

1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$650,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	fund to the commissioner of natural resources to develop approximately 0.6 of a mile of
1.9	new trail through Faribault and a bridge over the Cannon River that will connect the
1.10	eastern terminus of the Sakatah Singing Hills Trail to the western-most segment of the
1.11	Mill Towns State Trail at the White Sands Trail Head.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
1.13	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
