1.8	its designee of any agency that maintains corrections and detention data may shall release
1.9	private or confidential corrections and detention data to any law enforcement agency, if
1.10	necessary for law enforcement purposes, or to the victim of a criminal act where the data
1.11	are necessary for the victim to assert the victim's legal right to restitution.
1.12	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
