1.8	(a) In fiscal years 2016 and 2017, the commissioner of transportation shall
1.9	implement efficiencies identified by the Transportation Strategic Management and
1.10	Operations Advisory Task Force report under Laws 2008, chapter 152, article 6, section 9,
1.11	equal to 15 percent of the Department of Transportation's total appropriations for fiscal
1.12	years 2014 and 2015.
1.13	(b) The efficiency savings amount identified in paragraph (a) is appropriated to
