1.6	Section 1. LAKE REDWOOD RECLAMATION AND ENHANCEMENT PROJECTS
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$7,825,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency for a grant to the Redwood-Cottonwood
1.9	Rivers control area, a joint powers entity, to predesign, design, construct, and equip the
1.10	reservoir reclamation and enhancement of the 66-acre Lake Redwood Reservoir, to remove
1.11	approximately 650,000 cubic yards of sediment and increase its depth from 2.8 feet to 20
1.12	feet in order to secure renewable energy capacity of the hydroelectric dam which is impeded
