1.10	the moratorium exceptions process under section 144A.073 to calculate the facility's property
1.11	rate beginning July 1, 2024.
1.12	(b) For the purposes of determining the total property payment rate under section 256R.26
1.13	upon completion of the project for the facility described in paragraph (a), the final building
1.14	valuation is equal to the greater of the limited depreciated replacement cost as determined
1.15	under section 256R.26, subdivision 3, following a physical building appraisal or 105 percent

of the estimated total building valuation from the moratorium application.
