Subd.	2. Reforestation. \$8,000,000 of this appropriation is to provide for reforestation,
including	stand improvement related to reforestation, on state forest lands to meet the
reforestat	tion requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 89.002, subdivision 2, including
ourchasir	ng native seeds and native seedlings, planting, seeding, site preparation, and
protection	n on state lands administered by the commissioner.
