1.6	Subdivision 1. Required coverage. Every health plan must provide coverage for
1.7	intermittent urinary catheters if intermittent catheterization is recommended by the enrollee's
1.8	health care provider. Up to 120 intermittent catheters per month must be covered unless a
1.9	lesser amount is prescribed by the enrollee's health care provider.
1.10	Subd. 2. Cost-sharing requirements. No health plan may impose a deductible,
1.11	co-payment, coinsurance, or other restriction on intermittent catheters that the health plan
1.12	does not apply to durable medical equipment in general.
