1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 410.121, is amended to read:
1.7	410.121 SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR WINE; FAVORABLE VOTE
1.8	LICENSES.
1.9	If the charter which is to be amended or replaced contains provisions which prohibit the
1.10	sale of intoxicating liquor or wine in certain areas, such provisions shall not be amended or
1.11	removed unless 55 percent of the votes cast on the proposition shall be in favor thereof.
1.12	Notwithstanding any other law, a city charter may not restrict the ability of a city to issue
1.13	an intoxicating liquor license otherwise in compliance with applicable law.
1.14	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
