\$500,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$4,500,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Logistic Specialties, Inc. to create a pilot workforce and business development program in the east metropolitan area focused on government contract procurement and targeted to low- and moderate-income communities of color. Every six months, beginning on December 1.10 15, 2018, the commissioner must submit a brief update on the progress of the pilot project 1.11 to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction 1 12 over economic development. A final report on pilot outcomes must be submitted to the 1.13 chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over 1.14 economic development by February 15, 2020.
