1.10	must contract with one or more independent mental health organizations to provide mental
1.11	health care on campus at each state university and state college. Mental health services must
1.12	be provided without charge to students who are uninsured or whose health insurance does
1.13	not cover the service provided.
1.14	(b) A mental health organization providing mental health care under paragraph (a) must
1.15	also provide information and guidance to students seeking health insurance.
