1.3	of firearms eligibility prior to transferring a firearm; amending Minnesota Statutes

1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 609.66, subdivision 1f, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 1f. Gross misdemeanor; transferring firearm without background check. (a)
1.8	A person, other than a federally licensed firearms dealer, who transfers a pistol or
1.9	semiautomatic military-style assault weapon to another without complying with the transfer
1.10	requirements of section 624.7132, is guilty of a gross misdemeanor if the transferee possesses
1.11	or uses the weapon within one year after the transfer in furtherance of a felony crime of
1.12	violence, and if:
1.13	(1) the transferee was prohibited from possessing the weapon under section 624.713 at
1.14	the time of the transfer; or
1.15	(2) it was reasonably foreseeable at the time of the transfer that the transferee was likely
1.16	to use or possess the weapon in furtherance of a felony crime of violence.
1.17	(b) A person is immune from prosecution under paragraph (a) if the person produces
1.18	either a copy of the transferee's permit to carry or permit to purchase that the transferee
1.19	presented at the time of transfer. A transferor may only be required to produce documents
1.20	maintained pursuant to this paragraph if a court orders production of the documents as part
1.21	of a criminal investigation involving the transferred firearm. A court may not compel a
1.22	transferor to produce documents maintained pursuant to this paragraph beyond one year
1.23	after the date of transfer.
