1.5	Section 1. [626.8434] WARRIOR-STYLE TRAINING PROHIBITED.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Definition. For purposes of this section, "warrior-style training" means
1.7	training for peace officers that teaches that self-preservation of an officer is an officer's
1.8	highest priority or that trains peace officers to approach each interaction with a citizen as a
1.9	threat, or potential threat, to an officer's safety.
1.10	Subd. 2. No continuing education credits or tuition reimbursement. (a) The board
1.11	may not certify a continuing education course that includes warrior-style training.
1.12	(b) The board may not grant continuing education credit to a peace officer for a course
1.13	that includes warrior-style training.
1.14	(c) The board may not reimburse a law enforcement agency or a peace officer for a
1.15	course that includes warrior-style training.
1.16	Subd. 3. Training prohibited. A law enforcement agency may not provide warrior-style
1.17	training, directly or through a third party, to a peace officer.
