1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for wastewater treatment
1.3 facility improvements to the city of Albert Lea; authorizing the sale and issuance
1.4 of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. ALBERT LEA; WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY
1.7 IMPROVEMENTS; PHASE ONE.

1.8 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,900,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.9 to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Albert Lea to design, construct,
1.10 and equip renovations for the preliminary treatment building and septage and wastewater
1.11 receiving station at the city's wastewater treatment facility. This appropriation includes
1.12 money for renovation, repairs, and replacement of components of the facility's wastewater
1.13 treatment systems; site improvements to buildings and other structures; and demolition
1.14 associated with this phase of the project. This appropriation is available when the
1.15 commissioner of management and budget determines that sufficient resources have been
1.16 committed to complete the project, as required by Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.

1.17 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.18 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.19 the state in an amount up to \$4,900,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.20 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.21 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.22 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
