1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. BROOKLYN PARK; COMMUNITY ACTIVITY CENTER.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$12,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8 fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city
1.9 of Brooklyn Park to construct, furnish, and equip a new addition to the Brooklyn Park
1.10 community activity center, including multicourt gymnasium space.

1.11 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.12 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.13 the state in an amount up to \$12,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.14 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.15 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
