1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 252.27, subdivision 1a, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 1a. Definitions. A "related condition" is a condition (1) that is found to be
1.8	closely related to developmental disability, including, but not limited to, cerebral palsy,
1.9	epilepsy, autism, fetal alcohol spectrum disorder, and (2) Prader-Willi syndrome, and that
1.10	meets all of the following criteria:
1.11	(1) (i) is severe and chronic;
1.12	(2) (ii) results in impairment of general intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior
