1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 340A.101, subdivision 11, is amended to

1.8 Subd. 11. **Farm winery.** "Farm winery" ~~is~~ means a winery ~~operated by the owner of a~~
1.9 ~~Minnesota farm and~~ producing table, sparkling, or fortified wines from grapes, grape juice,
1.10 other fruit bases, or honey with a majority of the ingredients grown or produced in Minnesota.

1.11 Sec. 2. **REPEALER.**

1.12 Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 340A.315, subdivision 9, is repealed.

APPENDIX
Repealed Minnesota Statutes: 21-00608

340A.315 FARM WINERY LICENSE.

Subd. 9. **Agricultural land.** A farm winery license must be issued for operation of a farm winery on agricultural land, operating under an agricultural classification, zone, or conditional use permit. Farm wineries with licenses issued prior to March 1, 2012, are exempt from this provision.
