.9	of any student. The policy shall address intimidation and bullying in all forms, including,
.10	but not limited to, electronic forms and forms involving Internet use. The policy must
.11	require school staff to notify a student's parent or guardian when a student intimidates or
.12	bullies another student in violation of the policy and what disciplinary action results
.13	as a consequence.
