1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 65B.49, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8 Subd. 10. **Time limitations.** (a) Unless expressly provided for in this chapter, a plan of

1.9 reparation security must conform to the six-year time limitation provided under section

1.10 541.05, subdivision 1, clause (1).

1.11 (b) The time limitation for commencing a cause of action relating to underinsured motorist

1.12 coverage under section 65B.49, subdivision 3a, is four years from the date of accrual.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective on August 1, 2023, and applies to contracts

1.14 issued or renewed on or after that date.
