Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 273.063, is amended to read: 1.5 273.063 APPLICATION; LIMITATIONS. 1.6 The provisions of sections 272.161, 273.061, 273.062, 273.063, 273.072, 273.08, 273.10, 1.7 274.01, and 375.192 shall apply to all counties except Ramsey County. The following 1.8 limitations shall apply as to the extent of the county assessors jurisdiction: 1.9 In counties having a city of the first class, all the powers and duties of the county assessor 1.10 within such city shall be performed by the duly appointed city assessor. In all other cities 1.11 having a population of 30,000 persons or more, according to the last preceding federal 1.12 census, except in counties having a county assessor on January 1, 1967, the powers and 1.13 duties of the county assessor identified in section 273.061, subdivision 8, clauses (5) to 1.14 (16), within such cities shall be performed by the duly appointed city assessor, provided 1.15 that the county assessor shall retain the supervisory duties contained in section 273.061, 1.16 subdivision 8. For purposes of this section, "powers and duties" means the powers and duties 1.17
