1.8	from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to nonprofit
1.9	organizations to provide chemical dependency prevention programs in secondary schools.
1.10	An applicant for the grant funds must demonstrate expertise and prior experience in
1.11	providing prevention programming in secondary educational environments. An applicant
