Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 17.1016, subdivision 2, is amended to read: 1.6 Subd. 2. Grant program. (a) The commissioner may establish and implement a grant 1.7 program to help farmers finance new cooperatives that organize for purposes of operating 1.8 an agricultural product processing facility or marketing an agricultural product or agricultural 1.9 service. 1.10 (b) To be eligible for this program, a grantee must: 1.11 (1) be a cooperative organized under chapter 308A or 308B; 1.12 (2) certify that all control and equity in of the cooperative is from farmers, family farm 1.13 partnerships, family farm limited liability companies, or family farm corporations as defined 1.14 in section 500.24, subdivision 2, who are actively engaged in agricultural commodity 1.15 production; 1.16 (3) be operated primarily to process agricultural commodities or market agricultural 1.17 products or services produced in Minnesota; and 1.18 (4) receive agricultural commodities produced primarily by shareholders or members 1.19 1.20 of the cooperative; and

(c) The commissioner may receive applications and make grants up to \$50,000 to eligible grantees for feasibility, marketing analysis, assistance with organizational development, financing and managing new cooperatives, product development, development of business and marketing plans, and predesign of facilities, including site analysis, the development of bid specifications, preliminary blueprints and schematics, and the completion of purchase agreements and other necessary legal documents.

(d) Grants must be matched dollar-for-dollar with other money or in-kind contributions.
