BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT PATHFINDER COMPANION PILOT PROJECT.

- (a) The commissioner of human services, in consultation with the North Metro Mental Health Roundtable, shall conduct a one-year pilot project beginning September 1, 2021, that monitors the use of the Pathfinder Companion application, which includes a phone-based application that allows individuals in recovery to connect with peers, resources, providers, and others helping with recovery after an individual is discharged from treatment, and a computer-based application that allows providers to prioritize care, connect directly with patients, and monitor long-term outcomes and recovery effectiveness, by individuals in substance use disorder recovery and their providers, in order to evaluate the effects of the application on treatment outcomes described in paragraph (b).
- (b) The pilot project shall monitor and evaluate the effects of using the Pathfinder Companion application on treatment outcomes, including but not limited to tracking and analyzing information regarding participants' engagement with the application, social activity levels, and other social determinants, in order to consider whether the addition of digital recovery support services alongside traditional methods of recovery treatment improves treatment outcomes.
- (c) The commissioner of human services, in consultation with the North Metro Mental Health Roundtable, shall report on the results of the pilot project to the chairs and ranking
