1.6	Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES; APPROPRIATION.
1.7	(a) \$10,683,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of
1.8	human services in fiscal year 2015 for the purposes specified by and to supplement the
