1.2 relating to teachers; reducing school district reporting; amending Minnesota Statutes
1.3 2020, section 122A.091, subdivision 3.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 122A.091, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 3. **School district reports.** (a) School districts annually by October 1 must report
1.7 to the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board the following information for
1.8 all teachers who finished the probationary period and accepted a continuing contract position
1.9 with the district from September 1 of the previous year through August 31 of the current
1.10 year:

1.11 (1) the effectiveness category or rating of the teacher on the summative evaluation under
1.12 section 122A.40, subdivision 8, or 122A.41, subdivision 5;

1.13 (2) the licensure area in which the teacher primarily taught during the three-year
1.14 evaluation cycle; and

1.15 (3) the teacher preparation program preparing the teacher in the teacher's primary areas
1.16 of instruction and licensure.
