BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION; CLIMATE RESILIENCY PROGRAM.

\$1,358,000 in fiscal year 2022 and \$1,606,000 in fiscal year 2023 are appropriated to the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency to establish and implement a climate resiliency program providing technical assistance and grants to local governmental units and Tribal Governments. Climate resiliency technical assistance and grants may fund climate risk assessment, planning, and pre-design necessary for infrastructure bond funding to address issues of community flooding and wastewater treatment system overflows caused by inadequate stormwater or sanitary sewer infrastructure.
