1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to environment; appropriating money for climate resiliency program.
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; CLIMATE RESILIENCY PROGRAM.**

1.5 \$1,358,000 in fiscal year 2022 and \$1,606,000 in fiscal year 2023 are appropriated to
1.6 the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency to establish and implement a climate
1.7 resiliency program providing technical assistance and grants to local governmental units
1.8 and Tribal Governments. Climate resiliency technical assistance and grants may fund climate
1.9 risk assessment, planning, and pre-design necessary for infrastructure bond funding to
1.10 address issues of community flooding and wastewater treatment system overflows caused
1.11 by inadequate stormwater or sanitary sewer infrastructure.
