1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; adding an exception to the prohibition on concealing
1.3 identity; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 609.735.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 609.735, is amended to read:

1.6 **609.735 CONCEALING IDENTITY.**

1.7 A person whose identity is concealed by the person in a public place by means of a robe,
1.8 mask, or other disguise, unless based on religious beliefs, or incidental to amusement,
1.9 entertainment, protection from weather, the spread of infectious disease, or for medical
1.10 treatment, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
