BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. <u>HIV PREVENTION GRANTS.</u>

\$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated.

\$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of health for grants to nonprofit organizations for projects aimed at preventing the spread of HIV/AIDS, targeting communities at high risk for HIV infection, and for individuals living with HIV/AIDS. Grants shall be awarded on a request for proposal basis and priority shall be given to organizations that have experience in dealing with issues relating to HIV/AIDS.
