1.2 relating to health; appropriating money for advanced care planning on end-of-life

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION FOR ADVANCED CARE PLANNING.**

1.6 \$500,000 in fiscal year 2018 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7 of health to award a grant to a statewide advanced care planning resource organization that

1.8 has expertise in convening and coordinating community-based strategies to encourage

1.9 individuals, families, caregivers, and health care providers to begin conversations regarding

1.10 end-of-life care choices that express an individual's health care values and preferences and

1.11 are based on informed health care decisions. \$500,000 is added to the base appropriation

1.12 beginning in fiscal year 2019 and continuing in each fiscal year thereafter for grants for

1.13 advanced care planning.
