1.8	Subdivision 1. Definition. For the purposes of this section, "multifamily building" means
1.9	an apartment facility containing four or more dwelling units, each to be rented by a person
1.10	or family for use as a residence.
1.11	Subd. 2. Grant program established. The commissioner must establish a competitive
1.12	grant program to provide financial assistance to develop and implement pilot projects that
1.13	encourage and increase composting by residents of multifamily buildings in areas where
1.14	compost is not collected at curbside. Each grant must include an educational component on
1.15	the methods and benefits of composting.
1.16	Subd. 3. Eligible applicants. A grant may be awarded under this section to:
1.17	(1) a political subdivision;
1.18	(2) an owner of a multifamily building; or
1.19	(3) an organization that is exempt from taxation under section $501(c)(3)$ of the Internal
1.20	Revenue Code.
1.21	Subd. 4. Application. The commissioner must develop forms and procedures for
1.22	soliciting and reviewing applications for grants under this section.
