1.8	general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to the Heartland Girls Ranch
1.9	in Benson to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a house with capacity for ten
1.10	beds, and a second horse riding arena.
1.11	Subd. 2. Life House, Duluth. \$500,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.12	commissioner of human services for a grant to Life House in Duluth to complete the
1.13	renovation of the ten-bed transitional shelter and adjacent building to accommodate the
1.14	expansion of supportive services, including education and employment.
1.15	Subd. 3. The Link, Twin Cities Metropolitan Area. \$1,500,000 is appropriated from
1.16	the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to The Link to purchase
1.17	the Passageways Emergency Shelter and Housing land and building, and to predesign,
1.18	design, construct, furnish, and equip an addition to the building to provide for ten to 15
1.19	additional units.
