1.2 relating to health; transferring the comprehensive advanced life-support  
1.3 educational program to the commissioner of health; amending Minnesota  
1.4 Statutes 2008, section 144E.37.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 144E.37, is amended to read:

1.7 **144E.37 COMPREHENSIVE ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT.**

1.8 The ~~board~~ commissioner of health shall establish a comprehensive advanced  
1.9 life-support educational program to train rural medical personnel, including physicians,  
1.10 physician assistants, nurses, and allied health care providers, in a team approach to  
1.11 anticipate, recognize, and treat life-threatening emergencies before serious injury or  
1.12 cardiac arrest occurs.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2010.

1.14 Sec. 2. **TRANSFER.**

1.15 The powers and duties of the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board with  
1.16 respect to the comprehensive advanced life-support educational program under Minnesota  
1.17 Statutes, section 144E.37, are transferred to the commissioner of health under Minnesota  
1.18 Statutes, section 15.039.

1.19 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2010.

1.20 Sec. 3. **FUNDING TRANSFER.**

2.5 Sec. 4. **REVISOR'S INSTRUCTION.**

2.6 The revisor of statutes shall renumber Minnesota Statutes, section 144E.37, as  
2.7 Minnesota Statutes, section 144.6062, and make all necessary changes in statutory  
2.8 cross-references in Minnesota Statutes and Minnesota Rules.

2.9 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2010.
