OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to natural resources; appropriating money for outdoor recreation.
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; OUTDOOR RECREATION.**

1.5 \$118,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.6 commissioner of natural resources for modernizing Minnesota's state-managed outdoor
1.7 recreation experiences. Of this amount, \$28,000,000 is for enhancing access and welcoming
1.8 new users to public lands and outdoor recreation facilities; \$5,000,000 is for modernizing
1.9 camping and related infrastructure; \$35,000,000 is for modernizing boating access;
1.10 \$35,000,000 is for modernizing fish hatcheries and fishing infrastructure; and \$15,000,000
1.11 is for restoring streams and modernizing water-related infrastructure. The commissioner
1.12 may reallocate across these purposes based on project readiness and priority.
