BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [16A.092] DO NOT PAY DATABASE.

Subdivision 1. **Do not pay database.** The commissioner, with assistance from the

1.8

commissioner of information technology services, must maintain a database of individuals

1.9

or businesses who are prohibited from receiving state money. The commissioner must add

1.10

a person to the database when the person passes away, is convicted of or suspected of fraud

1.11

against the state, or owes money to the state.

1.12

Subd. 2. **Contributions from all agencies.** All state agencies must provide names and

1.13

data to the commissioner for addition to the database when the agency determines that a

1.14

person has passed away, is convicted of or suspected of fraud against the state, or owes

1.15

money to the state.

1.16

Subd. 3. **Confirmation of status before action.** The commissioner must make the

1.17

database available to agencies. Before entering a contract or making a payment, an agency

1.18

must check the name of a vendor or payment recipient against the database to ensure the

1.19

person or business is eligible to contract or receive a payment.
