1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; appropriating money for a grant to Village Arms.
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. APPROPRIATION; VILLAGE ARMS.

1.5 \$300,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$300,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the
1.6 general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to Village Arms for services
1.7 to address racial disparities in child welfare outcomes. Grant money may be used for staffing,
1.8 administrative costs, and other program costs related to the following services:

- 1.9 (1) prepermanency and postpermanency advocacy;
- 1.10 (2) assisting parents with case plan completion;
- 1.11 (3) parent coaching and education;
- 1.12 (4) supervised visitation;
- 1.13 (5) in-home visits; and
- 1.14 (6) family support services.

1.15 This is a onetime appropriation.
