1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; providing a grant for a culturally specific food shelf
1.3 in the east metro; appropriating money.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; CULTURALLY SPECIFIC FOOD SHELF.**

1.6 \$100,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$100,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the
1.7 general fund to the commissioner of human services to provide a grant to an organization
1.8 that provides emergency services and referrals for American Indian families and operates
1.9 a culturally specific food shelf on the east side of the seven-county metropolitan area. Grant
1.10 funds must be used for the food shelf to purchase, transport, and coordinate the distribution
1.11 of nutritious food to needy individuals and families.
