1.6	(a) \$4,729,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.7	commissioner of public safety for a grant to a nonprofit organization under section 501(c)(3)
1.8	of the Internal Revenue Code located in the city of Roseville, to acquire property for, and
1.9	to predesign, design, construct, renovate, furnish, and equip a regional emergency disaster

1.11	(b) The new emergency disaster services center must allow for the strategic stockpiling
