1.13	federal law to be financing human conflict. Conflict mineral includes columbite-tantalite
1.14	(coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or derivatives of those minerals.
1.15	(c) "Noncompliant person" means a person:
1.16	(1) who is required to disclose under federal law information relating to conflict
1.17	minerals that originated in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or its neighboring

1.19	(2) for whom the disclosure is not filed, is considered under federal law to be an
1.20	unreliable determination, or contains false information.
1.21	Subd. 2. Prohibition. No commissioner, head, or chief administrative officer of an
