.7	\$ in fiscal year 2017 is appropriated from the general fund to the Metropolitan

.9	Community Council, District 2 Community Council, District 4 Dayton's Bluff Community
.10	Council, and Payne-Phalen District 5 Planning Council. The grants must be used for
.11	outreach, education, and engagement to minority communities concerning the status and
