| 1.8 | The Office of Ombudsperson for the Department of Corrections is hereby created. The |
| 1.9 | ombudsperson shall serve at the pleasure of be appointed by the governor in the unclassified |
| 1.10 | service, and may be removed only for just cause. The ombudsperson shall be selected without |
| 1.11 | regard to political affiliation, and shall be a person highly competent and qualified to analyze |
| 1.12 | questions of law, administration, and public policy. No person may serve as ombudsperson |
| 1.13 | while holding any other public office. The ombudsperson for corrections shall be accountable |
| 1.14 | to the governor and shall have the authority to investigate decisions, acts, and other matters |
| 1.15 | of the Department of Corrections so as to promote the highest attainable standards of |
| 1.16 | competence, efficiency, and justice in the administration of corrections. |
