OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to environment; appropriating money for study of PFAS in biosolids.
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; REPORT ON PFAS IN LAND-APPLIED**
1.5 **BIOSOLIDS.**

1.6 \$...... in fiscal year is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of the
1.7 Pollution Control Agency to study the effects of land-applied biosolids on the spread of
1.8 perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). By December 1,, the commissioner
1.9 must submit a report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees
1.10 and divisions with jurisdiction over environment and natural resources and agriculture. The
1.11 report must:

1.12 (1) evaluate and characterize PFAS concentrations in land-applied biosolids, leaching
1.13 of PFAS from those wastes, and the subsequent movement of PFAS into water and food;

1.14 (2) identify alternative disposal and treatment options; and

1.15 (3) make recommendations for developing tools for managing PFAS-contaminated waste
1.16 streams.
