1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 181.9414, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 1a. **Emergency medical technicians.** An employer of an emergency medical
1.9 technician (EMT) licensed under section 144E.001, subdivision 5c or 5e, must provide the
1.10 accommodations in this section regardless of a showing of undue hardship under subdivision
1.11 1. A pregnant EMT who requests an accommodation under this section must be assigned
1.12 light duty support work.
