OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to consumer protection; requiring disclosures for electronic entertainment;
1.3 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 325G.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **325G.38] HANDHELD ELECTRONIC DEVICES; DISCLOSURES.**

1.6 If a retail establishment offers consumers the use of handheld electronic devices that
1.7 require payment for games or other entertainment, the handheld electronic device must
1.8 display a disclosure. The disclosure must be provided to the consumer before a game or
1.9 entertainment is purchased and must:

1.10 (1) require the user to affirm that the user is 18 years of age or older; and

1.11 (2) include, in at least ten-point font and larger than all other type viewable on the screen
1.12 at that time, the payment amount required.
